

Regulation for sport to World Company Sport Games 2026 Frederikshavn, Denmark

Sport: ARCHERY

Competition form: Individual, double and Team tournament

Venue: FFI Opvisningsbane, Arena Nord, Harald Nielsens Plads 9, 9900

Frederikshavn

Dates: June 11-12, 2026

Schedule: Matches will start at 9.00 in the morning and end about 17.30/18.00.

Events you do not want to miss:

Opening Ceremony June 10, In the evening!

Dinner and party in Arena Nord June 11 and 12 from 18.00

Open Run 5 og 10 K, June 13 at 16.00! Closing Ceremony June 13 in the evening!

Prizes: Medals for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in individuals.

Medals for the 1st place, in team and double

Required Qualifications: Participation is open to all team members who are duly registered, have

paid the registration fee.

Categories: Men Open Single in Recurve Olympic, Compound, Barebow or Longbow

Women Open Single in Recurve Olympic, Compound, Barebow or Longbow Team Open * - consist of 3 shooters, men and/or women. Team members must belong to the same Division (Recurve Olympic, Compound, Barebow,

Longbow).

Double Open Mix * – consist of 2 shooters, 1 male and 1 femail, Double members must belong to the same Division (Recurve Olympic, Compound,

Barebow, Longbow).

* It is only possible to participate in either Team or Double!

Note: The organizers reserve the right to modify the number of categories

based on the number of registered participants.

Game format: The competition will consist of a target shooting event for Recurve Olympic,

Compound, Barebow or Longbow, each shooter can only participate in one division! The qualifying phase will be held with a double series (2x36 arrows) at a distance of 50 meters with a 122 cm target (80 cm reduced target for

Compound). Official shots will be held on the competition field.

• The elimination rounds and finals will be held at the same distances as the

qualifying round.

• The elimination rounds will be arranged to ensure each participant

competes in at least one match.

The shooting times per end will be those provided by WA (ends of 6 arrows in

240 seconds). Recurve Olympic bow, Barebow, and Longbow Divisions will shoot on a 122 cm target. The Compound Division will shoot on an 80 cm reduced target (10-5).

Team Tournament: A team consists of 3 shooters. The team's qualifying result will be the sum of

its members' scores in the individual tournament. Teams may be mixed (male and female), and members must belong to the same Division (Recurve

Olympic, Compound, Barebow, Longbow).

There will be a final shooting, with the best Teams!

Double Tournament: A double consists of 2 shooters. The double's qualifying result will be the

sum of its members' scores in the individual tournament. Doubles must be

mixed (1 male and 1 female), and members must belong to the same

Division (Recurve Olympic, Compound, Barebow, Longbow).

There will be a final shooting, with the best doubles!

Other rules: For any matters not covered in above regulations, the Rules of World Archery

for target shooting competitions, as regulated in WA Book 3, shall apply, with

the sole exception of the distance reduced to 50 meters.

Presentation: Shooter must be present at the check-in station at the sport facility 30

minutes before the start.

Team Manager: Each team must have its own team manager, who can also be the coach.

The team manager must sign the list of teamplayers (Roster Sheet) before

the shooting.

Results: The results will be published on the official information system

"Goodiepack", in the archery section.

Doping: Participation is not allowed if you have tested positive in a doping-test 2

years before!

There can be unannounced doping test – if so, participant is obliged to be

tested.

Protests: All protests related to the conduct of the championship must be submitted

in writing to the Head Judge at the local sport facilitation within a maximum of 30 minutes after the conclusion of the match, accompanied by a deposit

of €30.00, which will be refunded if the appeal is accepted.

Final Provisions: Each participant travels and participates in the Games at their own risk. The

organization is responsible only for first aid. It is mandatory to always carry a

copy of personal insurance policy.
