Regulation for sport to World Company Sport Games 2026 Frederikshavn, Denmark

- Sport:** BILLARD (Cone Billard)

- Competition form:** Singles tournament, with handicap distance*
- Venue:** Arena Nord, Harald Nielsens Plads 9, 9900 Frederikshavn
and
Sæby Spektrum, Sæbygårdsvej 32, 9300 Sæby
- Dates:** June 11.-12.-13. 2026
- Schedule:** Matches will start at 9.00 in the morning and end about 17.30/18.00 on the 11.-12. and at Final day the 13. it ends no later than 14.00!
On the 11. the day start with training games for all players without a registered “handicap distance”. In 2 games we make the individual handicap distance. *
The tournament starts the 11 at around 13.00
- Events you do not want to miss:**
Opening Ceremony June 10, In the evening!
Dinner and party in Arena Nord June 11 and 12 from 18.00
Open Run 5 og 10 K, June 13 at 16.00!
Closing Ceremony June 13 in the evening!
- Prizes:** Medals for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams in each category.
- Required Qualifications:** Participation is open to all team members who are duly registered, have paid the registration fee.
- Categories:** Men Open
Women Open
Note: The organizers reserve the right to modify the number of categories based on the number of registered participants.
- Game format:** The tournament is play as a Handicap distance tournament*. This means that all players have a distance they normally play.
*Each player’s Distance is calculated by using the average of how many points you score at the table in one entry!
Each player’s handicap distance is multiplied with 25 and + 20. This is the score each player has to reach in a game.
The first phase consists of round-robin groups of 4-6 players.
At the end of these matches, a ranking is established based on:
1. Number of matches won
2. In the case of tie, based the best total average of the played games in the group stage.

The top 2-3 players in each group advance to the GOLD bracket, while the other players advance to the SILVER bracket (optional).

The GOLD and SILVER brackets proceed with single-elimination rounds.

Officiating:	<p>The officiating will be done by the players themselves. Players are required to serve as “score counter” and “cone sets up” for matches based on the following regulations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- In the group stage, the players not playing.- In the elimination matches, the players that lost the previous match at the same table.
Other rules:	<p>For any matters not covered in above regulations, the Rules of the Danish Billiard Federation (DDBU) shall apply.</p>
Presentation:	<p>Players must be present at the check-in at the sport facility 30 minutes before the start of the match. If the player is not on the table at the scheduled start time, they will forfeit the match.</p> <p>Note: Players must be present on the table at the scheduled time for the match they are to play.</p>
Results:	<p>The results will be published on the official information system “Goodiepack”, in the billiard section.</p>
Doping:	<p>Participation is not allowed if you have tested positive in a doping-test 2 years before!</p> <p>There can be unannounced doping test – if so, participant is obliged to be tested.</p>
Protests:	<p>All protests related to the conduct of the championship must be submitted in writing to the Head Judge at the local sport facilitation within a maximum of 30 minutes after the conclusion of the match, accompanied by a deposit of €30.00, which will be refunded if the appeal is accepted.</p>
Final Provisions:	<p>Each participant travels and participates in the Games at their own risk. The organization is responsible only for first aid. It is mandatory to always carry a copy of personal insurance policy.</p>
