

Regulation for sport to World Company Sport Games 2026 Frederikshavn, Denmark

Sport: BRIDGE

Competition form: Double tournament

Venue: Maskinhallen, Skolegade 8, 9900 Frederikshavn

Dates: June 11-12, 2026

Schedule: The play will start at 10.00 in the morning and end at about 17.30/18.00 on

June 11-12. On both days there will be a lunch break. On both days there will

be two sessions of doubles tournament.

Events you do not want to miss:

Opening Ceremony June 10, In the evening!

Dinner and party in Arena Nord June 11 and 12 from 18.00

Open Run 5 og 10 K, June 13 at 16.00! Closing Ceremony June 13 in the evening!

Prizes: Medals for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.

Required Qualifications: Participation is open to all pair members who are duly registered, have paid

the registration fee.

Categories: Mix Open, men and/or women

Game format: Match point Tournament

Systems:

WBF Laws, 2017 Edition, officially in use. HUM (Highly Unusual Methods) and Brown Stickers are not allowed. Psychic bids are not allowed at any time during the bidding. Single round-robin with separate rankings for the Mixed

Open and Women's Open categories.

Alert: Any call that has a special or artificial meaning must be immediately made known to the opponents using the alert card. Since the event is attended by people from various nations where different bidding systems, natural and conventional, are in use, players are recommended to keep them as simple as possible and alert when necessary. When in doubt, it is advisable to always use the alert card. The "Double" is not alerted (but opponents are always free to ask), except when it has a specific artificial meaning. Both members of the pair must adopt the same meaning for both bidding calls and defensive card play. Each pair must have a convention card written in English.

Program: The number of boards during each session will be determined by the number of players registered for the tournament and actually present at the various game sessions. In any case, the completion of a regular tournament in all its phases of at least 20 boards per session will be

guaranteed.

Other rules: For any matters not covered in the above regulations, the current

International Bridge Code of Conduct shall apply. The use of bridgemates is

permitted.

Presentation: Pairs must be present at the check-in station at the sport facility 30 minutes

before the start of the match. If the pair is not at the table at the scheduled

start time, they will forfeit the match.

Note: Players must be present at the table at the scheduled start time of the

match they are to play - only the local sport facilitator can give a

dispensation for this.

Results: During the tournament, the transcription of an incorrect result can be

corrected at any time, up to 10 minutes after the score for a specific session is printed. Any irregularity at the table must be immediately reported to the referee. If corrected by the players themselves, the innocent side forfeits any

right to compensation

The results will be published on the official information system

"Goodiepack", in the bridge section.

Doping: Participation is not allowed if you have tested positive in a doping-test 2

years before!

There can be unannounced doping test – if so participant is obliged to be

tested.

Protests: All protests related to the conduct of the championship must be submitted

in writing to the Head Judge at the local sport facilitation within a maximum of 30 minutes after the conclusion of the match, accompanied by a deposit

of €30.00, which will be refunded if the appeal is accepted.

Final Provisions: Each participant travels and participates in the Games at their own risk. The

organization is responsible only for first aid. It is mandatory to always carry a

copy of personal insurance policy.
