

## Regulation for sport to World Company Sport Games 2026 Frederikshavn, Denmark

**Sport:** SHOOTING

**Competition form:** Individual and Team tournament

Venue: Vodskov Skytteforening, Vodskovvej 103, 9310 Vodskov

**Dates:** June 11-12-13 2026

**Schedule:** Shooting will start at 9.00 in the morning and end no later than 17.30/18.00

on the 11-12 and at Final day the 13, it ends no later than 14.00!

Required Qualifications: Participation is open to all team members who are duly registered, have

paid the registration fee.

Rules for 40+

In ISSF air rifle benchrest events, the rifle may only be held with both hands, shoulder, cheek, and chest next to the right shoulder. The benchrest must be in firm contact with the support and may not be placed sideways on the rack. The support rest may not touch any part of the body. The rifle may only

be rested on the benchrest, not on the rack.

Note: The organizers reserve the right to modify the number of categories based on the number of registered participants.

**Game format:** 

Men (C10-P10) 60 shots

Women (C10-P10) 60 shots

Men 40 (40+) (C10 with support-P10 with support) 30 shots Women 40 (40+) (C10 with support-P10 with support) 30 shots

It will only be possible to compete in the C10 and P10, with support, for men and women over 40 years.

**Teams**: Each team consist of three shooters for each discipline, regardless of gender. The team members must be declared on a Roster Sheet, by the Team Manager, before the start of the competition. For the team ranking, the scores achieved in the qualification round will be counted.

The top 8 shooters in each discipline will advance to the Final.

The draw for the shooting lines will be made 15 days before the start of the competition.

The Final will follow ISSF regulations, and the top 8 shooters will start with a score of zero. See rules in this link!

**NOTE**: For the supported competition, each participant must provide their own support. All shooters must be on the shooting range at the assigned times.

WEAPONS, AMMUNITION, TARGETS, POSITIONS, DISTANCE, PRACTICE SHOTS, SHOTS ON TARGETS, RESHOOTS, RANKINGS, GRADING, AND PROTESTS: As per the Regulatory Rules for Shooting Activities of UITS and the regulations of the International Shooting Sport Federation (ISSF).

**WEAPON AND EQUIPMENT CHECK**: This will be carried out before the start of the competition.

Other rules: For any matters not covered in above regulations, the Rules of the

International Federation (ISSF) shall apply.

**Team Presentation:** Shooter must be present at the check-in station at the sport facility 30

minutes before the start of the shooting.

**Team Manager:** Each team must have its own team manager. The team manager must

submit the signed list of shooters (Roster Sheet).

**Results**: The results will be published on the official information system

"Goodiepack", in the shooting section.

**Doping:** Participation is not allowed if you have tested positive in a doping-test 2

years before!

There can be unannounced doping test – if so participant is obliged to be

tested.

**Protests:** All protests related to the conduct of the championship must be submitted

in writing to the Head Judge at the local sport facilitation within a maximum of 30 minutes after the conclusion of the match, accompanied by a deposit

of €30.00, which will be refunded if the appeal is accepted.

**Final Provisions**: Each participant travels and participates in the Games at their own risk. The

organization is responsible only for first aid. It is mandatory to always carry a

copy of personal insurance policy.
