Regulation for sport to World Company Sport Games 2026 Frederikshavn, Denmark

Sport: BOWLING

Competition form: Team tournament, with individual tournament included*

Venue: Terminalen Frederikshavn, Skippergade 36, 9900 Frederikshavn
and
Løvvang Bowling Center, Løvbakken 8, 9400 Nørresundby

The Final game on Saturday will be played in Frederikshavn!

Dates: June 11.-12.-13. 2026

Schedule: Matches will start at 9.00 in the morning and end about 17.30/18.00 on the 11.-12. and at Final day the 13. it ends no later than 14.00!

Events you do not want to miss:

Opening Ceremony June 10, In the evening!
Dinner and party in Arena Nord June 11 and 12 from 18.00
Open Run 5 og 10 K, June 13 at 16.00!
Closing Ceremony June 13 in the evening!

Prizes: Medals for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams and individual.

Required Qualifications: Participation is open to all team members who are duly registered, have paid the registration fee.

Categories: Open category
A team consists of 4 players. Women receive a handicap of 5 pins per game.
If a player gets injured and must withdraw, 125 pins will be added for him/her per game. A substitute player is allowed, but the substitute cannot come from another team.

Game format: All games are played according to European style (no lane change).

Each team plays a series of 3 games on Thursday (11. June) and on Friday (12. June). The top 8 teams with the highest total pins fall in the qualification/preliminary rounds will qualify for the final round on Saturday (13. June). In case of a tie, the team with the highest game of a single team member advances to the final phase. If still tie, the team with the highest game score of the second-best player of the team member advance to the final phase.

The 8 finalist teams will compete in single-game elimination matches in k.-o. system with total pins.

Pairings for the first game will be based on the result from qualification rounds – 1 against 8, 2 against 7, 3 against 6 and 4 against 5. After 1 game in first round the 4 winners go to A Semifinal, and the 4 losers go to B Semifinal.

It all ends with final game, bronze game and game for place 5,6,7 and 8. All 8 teams on final day will play 3 games!

* The games played in the qualification/preliminary round will also count towards the overall individual ranking: the top 3 players with the highest scores will be awarded with medals.

Presentation:

Players must be present at the check-in station at the sport facility 30 minutes before the start of the match. If the player is not present at the scheduled start time, they will forfeit the match.

Results:

The results will be published on the official information system “Goodiepack”, in the bowling section.

Doping:

Participation is not allowed if you have tested positive in a doping-test 2 years before!

There can be unannounced doping test – if so participant is obliged to be tested.

Protests:

All protests related to the conduct of the championship must be submitted in writing to the Head Judge at the local sport facilitation within a maximum of 30 minutes after the conclusion of the match, accompanied by a deposit of €30.00, which will be refunded if the appeal is accepted.

Final Provisions:

Each participant travels and participates in the Games at their own risk. The organization is responsible only for first aid. It is mandatory to always carry a copy of personal insurance policy.
