Regulation for sport to World Company Sport Games 2026 Frederikshavn, Denmark

Sport: VOLLEYBALL

Competition form: Teams tournament

Venue: Arena Nord, Harald Nielsen Plads 9, 9900 Frederikshavn
and
Privatskolen, Peter Wessels Vej 1, 9900 Frederikshavn

Dates: June 11.-12.-13. 2026

Schedule: Matches will start at 9.00 in the morning and end about 17.30/18.00 on the 11.-12. and at Final day the 13. it ends no later than 14.00!

Events you do not want to miss:

Opening Ceremony June 10, In the evening!
Dinner and party in Arena Nord June 11 and 12 from 18.00
Open Run 5 og 10 K, June 13 at 16.00!
Closing Ceremony June 13 in the evening!

Prizes: Medals for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams in each category.

Required Qualifications: Participation is open to all team members who are duly registered, have paid the registration fee.

Categories: Men Open and Men Open 40 (40+)
Women Open and Women Open 40(40+)
Mix Open and Mix Open 40 (40+)
Numbers of players per team: Min 6 and max 11 players per team per game.
In Mixed teams, there must always be at least 3 women on the court during play.
Note: The organizers reserve the right to modify the number of categories based on the number of registered participants.

Game format: Participating teams will be divided into groups, where each team will play against all other teams in the group. Afterward, there will be matched for all based on results ending with finals between the best-placed teams.
Matches will be played with the format of best of 3 sets (the 3rd set will only be played in the case of a tie after the first two sets are split 1-1, and at a score of 2-0, the 3rd set will not be played).
Each set is played to 25 points, and in the case of a score of 24-24, due to time constraints, the rule of two points difference will not apply, and the set will end at 25 points regardless. The interval between sets is a maximum of 5 minutes.
Each team can request a 30-second timeout per set.
Standings based on the match result:
• 2-0: 3 points awarded to the winning team, and 0 points to the losing team.

- 2-1: 2 points awarded to the winning team, and 1 point to the losing team

Teams are ranked in each group based on the highest number of points in the standings. In the event of a points tie in the standings between two teams, the result of the head-to-head match is considered. In case of a tie in the standings involving more than two teams, the ranking is based on the sum of the points in the standings from the head-to-head matches between the teams with the same points in the standings. In the event of further ties, the quotient of sets won and lost in all group matches is considered, and in case of further ties, the quotient of points scored and conceded in all sets played in all group matches.

Each participant can only play for one team.

In each match, only 12 players can play. The list of players must be submitted to the referees at least 10 minutes before the match.

Net Height:

Men's Tournaments: 2.43 meters

Women's Tournaments: 2.24 meters

Mixed Tournaments: 2.35 meters

Officiating:

There will be referees in all games.

The Teams must act scorers counting for matches based on the following regulations:

- In the group stage, the/a Team not playing.
- In the single-elimination or double-elimination bracket, the/a Team that lost the previous match on the same court.

Other rules:

For any matters not covered in above regulations, the Rules of the International Volleyball Federation (FIVB) shall apply.

Team Presentation:

Teams must be present at the check-in station at the sport facility 30 minutes before the start of the match. The team manager must submit the RS (Roster Sheet) form with the list of players participating in the match for each match. If the team is not on the field at the scheduled start time, they will forfeit the match.

Note: All players must be present on the field at the scheduled start time of the match they are to play – only the local sport facilitator can give a dispensation for this.

Team Manager:

Each team must have its own team manager, who can also be the coach. The team manager must sign the list of players (Roster Sheet).

Results:

The results will be published on the official information system “Goodiepack”, in the volleyball section.

Doping:

Participation is not allowed if you have tested positive in a doping-test 2 years before!

There can be unannounced doping test – if so, participant is obliged to be tested.

Protests:

All protests related to the conduct of the championship must be submitted in writing to the Head Judge at the local sport facilitation within a maximum of 30 minutes after the conclusion of the match, accompanied by a deposit of €30.00, which will be refunded if the appeal is accepted.

Final Provisions:

Each participant travels and participates in the Games at their own risk. The organization is responsible only for first aid. It is mandatory to always carry a copy of personal insurance policy.
