Regulation for sport to World Company Sport Games 2026 Frederikshavn, Denmark

Sport:	DART
Competition form:	Individual and Team tournament
Venue:	Det Musiske Hus, Rådhus Allé 98, 9900 Frederikshavn
Dates:	June 11.-12.-13. 2026
Schedule:	Matches will start at 9.00 in the morning and end about 17.30/18.00 on the 11.-12. and at the 13. it ends no later than 14.00!

Events you do not want to miss:

Opening Ceremony June 10, In the evening!
Dinner and party in Arena Nord June 11 and 12 from 18.00
Open Run 5 og 10 K, June 13 at 16.00!
Closing Ceremony June 13 in the evening!

Prizes: Medals for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams in each category.

Required Qualifications: Participation is open to all team members who are duly registered, have paid the registration fee.

Categories: Men Open Single
Women Open Single
Mix Open Double - consist of 2 players, men and/or women.

There will be a row for the disabled players in single, also for wheelchairs!

Note: The organizers reserve the right to modify the number of categories based on the number of registered participants.

Game format: All matches will be played with a starting score of 501 points, with a double-out requirement.
The single tournament will be conducted using the ABC Pool/CUP system to balance the differences in players' strengths.
Matches based on the group stage system will be played as best of 3 legs, while the final matches will be played as best of 5 legs.
After arrow 42 in a game, 1 arrow closest to the bull is played for decision.

We play with Steel darts, and players must bring their own darts!

Individual Tournament – will be held Thursday and Friday

The ranking of players in each group is based on points, with the player having the most points being the first-place finisher, the player with the second-most points being the second-place finisher, and so on.
In case of a tie between two players, the result of their head-to-head match will be considered.

In the event of another tie between two players, the player with the greatest difference between legs won and lost will be declared the winner.
In case of a further tie between two players, each player throws 9 darts. The highest score wins.

Double Tournament

The double tournament will be held as a knockout game on Saturday. With the same rules as in individual, but all games as best of 3 legs.

Officiating:	The officiating will be done by the players themselves. Players are required to serve as scorers and referees for matches based on the following regulations: - In the group stage, the players not playing are scorers and referees. - In the elimination games, the team that lost the previous match on the same court are scorers and referees.
Team Presentation:	Player and/or Teams must be present at the check-in station at the sport facility 30 minutes before the start of the match. The team manager must submit the RS (Roster Sheet) form with the list of players participating in the match for each match. If the player and/or the team is not on the field at the scheduled start time, they will forfeit the match. Note: All players must be present on the field at the scheduled start time of the match they are to play – only the local sport facilitator can give a dispensation for this.
Team Manager:	Each team must have its own team manager, who can also be the coach. The team manager must sign the list of players (Roster Sheet).
Results:	The results will be published on the official information system “Goodiepack”, in the dart section.
Doping:	Participation is not allowed if you have tested positive in a doping-test 2 years before! There can be unannounced doping test – if so participant is obliged to be tested.
Protests:	All protests related to the conduct of the championship must be submitted in writing to the Head Judge at the local sport facilitation within a maximum of 30 minutes after the conclusion of the match, accompanied by a deposit of €30.00, which will be refunded if the appeal is accepted.
Final Provisions:	Each participant travels and participates in the Games at their own risk. The organization is responsible only for first aid. It is mandatory to always carry a copy of personal insurance policy.
